MWBE Outreach Sessions

Compliance Tracking & Monitoring

- Develop and implement digital systems and analytical procedures to ensure the timely submission of required documentation, allowing our clients to have digital records, timestamps and ownership information for all documentation.
- Work directly with all contractors on each project and store their documents in an organized and accessible manner.
- Review certified payroll reports to verify hours, wages, benefits, gender, ethnicity, and mailing address as needed
 and track each contractor's performance against any equal employer opportunity (EEO) goals a project may
 require.
- Verify and track the use of local labor on client construction projects and use this information to analyze the financial impact a project may have on the local community.
- · Identify the wages paid to local workers and contract dollars paid to local MWBE contractors.

- Review and analyze payments and corresponding invoices issued to MWBEs throughout the duration of client construction projects in order to verify that MWBE subcontractors are conducting the work and receiving payment in a timely fashion.
- Track each contractor's performance against the relevant compliance goals on a monthly basis to follow each contractor's progress in real time thus preventing contractors from failing to fulfill their obligations and ensuring the utilization of the subcontractors they included in their utilization plans.
- Utilize Commercially Useful Function (CUF) monitoring as a tool to mitigate fraud including highlighting fraud risks such as pass-throughs, fronting, false records, in-field investigations and inspections, interviews, and reporting.
